Client Challenge

As a part of their long range master plan, Northwood University is working to eventually replace their South Village Housing with upgraded dormitories featuring modern living spaces.

TowerPinkster Solution

TowerPinkster is currently working with Northwood University to design two new 21st century apartment-style facilities within a recently purchased wooded property along the north side of campus. The buildings will be nestled into the trees with views to adjacent wetlands and open spaces. With a strong pedestrian connection to the heart of campus, the building will be part of students' transition from adolescence into adulthood.

The 59 units in each building will feature kitchens and living spaces in order to create apartment-style living. Each unit arrangement will range between two and four bedrooms, along with individual room options. When complete in June of 2017, the new buildings will replace the university's existing South Village Housing complex and upgrade the students' living and learning environments for years to come.
